Our university continues to increase the future value of our country and our science world with its deep-rooted history, universal education understanding, qualified academic infrastructure, generations and works.

DEPARK, which continues its activities in the Health Technopark Olive Building in 15 Temmuz Sağlık and Sanat Campus, Alpha and Beta Buildings in Buca Tinaztepe Campus, contributes to the development of local and national development-oriented entrepreneurship with R&D and innovation-based projects and collaborations.

The presence of our university hospital serving the Aegean Region and our relevant units in the field of health in the 15 Temmuz Sağlık and Sanat Campus has increased the strategic importance of the region in the field of health. Our institution, which has turned its predictions about the future in the field of health into reality over the years, started to operate the Advanced Biomedical Application and R&D Center, and then formed the structure that turned into the Izmir Biomedicine and Genome Center.

After a while, as a complementary element to the growth of our country in strategic areas, the Izmir International Institute of Biomedicine and Genome was established in 2015 with the initiatives of the University Senate of the period. In 2021, the Oral and Dental Health Application and Research Center was established within our University and started to serve the people of the region.

Our institution, which is one of the largest higher education institutions of our country, has 18 faculties including Buca Education, Maritime, Dentistry, Literature, Science, Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation, Fine Arts, Nursing, Law, Economics and Administrative Sciences, Theology, Business, Architecture, Engineering, Necat Hepkon Sports Sciences, Medical, Tourism and Veterinary Faculty. NUTRITION

A total of 4 kitchens serving within the Health, Culture and Sports Department of our University are producing meals and a total of 23 cafeterias serve an average of 12,000 people per day for lunch, secondary education, DEU Buca Kiz and

Dinner service is provided for male dormitory students.

Tinaztepe Kitchen located in Tinaztepe Campus has been renewed and has met the standards required for ISO 22000 certificate; has increased the quality and capacity of food service with updates.

Rural Sides of Izmir we have catering services in our faculties, colleges and vocational schools (Torbalı, Seferihisar, Selçuk, Urla, Bergama and Kiraz). Considering our daily menus, the calorie needs of our university students, our food engineer and are prepared with the experience of our masters under the control of our dietitian.

There are 4 types of menus in our kitchens. Our students can benefit from daily, optional day or weekly food services between 11:30-13:30 in the cafeterias affiliated to our University with the virtual money they upload to their Corporate Identity Cards.

In addition to the 6 canteens and cafeterias serving under the Department of Health, Culture and Sports of Dokuz Eylül University, our students and staff are provided with fast food, cold-hot drink, ready-to-eat food and nutrition services with a large number of private canteen businesses.

Flag Science and Turkish Flags Museum

The flag is the symbol of the existence and independence of a nation, the memory of its history. Its value does not depend on the fact that it is made of cotton, atlas and silk, but is measured by the value of the nation it represents.

The flag is respected because it represents the sovereignty, independence and honor of the state. With these feelings and thoughts, on September 9, 2020, the first and only national flag museum of Turkey, the day of liberation from the enemy occupation of our beautiful Izmir, by the Rectorate of our University, the founder of the Museum, DEU Rector Prof. Dr. Under the auspices of Nükhet HOTAR and the President of the Turkish Grand National Assembly Prof. Dr. Mustafa ŞENTOP.

Our museum consists of 3 exhibition halls, 1 multi-purpose hall, 1 children's museum room, 1 specialized library and 1 archive room. Our museum uses the 130-year-old historical Eylül Köşk building located in the Dokuzçeşmeler Campus of our University and is located on a 5-acre land.

As our Rector stated, "Of course, we have not forgotten the symbols of the states built by our ancestors and the flags of world civilizations in this museum, which will build a bridge between the past and the future and reinforce the patriotism of our children and young people. Here we have included the academic studies in which flag science is exclusive. Eylül Köşkü served our university and city for many years. We wanted to start a new chapter for him. After all, this place reflected the period of our city's liberation struggle and offered an environment where our visitors could have a peaceful time in the garden. We completed this national project, which brought a new breath to Buca, in a short time. "

In our Ay Yıldız halls, which are the main representation halls of our museum, the historical journey of Ay Yıldız is described with historical objects. The history of Turkish flags and flag science is also presented with interactive applications and multivision shows.

Information and document management is also carried out in our museum. Our museum continues its "open archive" works in line with the 2021 goals of our Presidency and YÖK. Distance education, which gained momentum with the pandemic, is open to online access to the museum's extensive collection in line with our distance access purposes.

The collection of our museum includes Veteran Flags from the National Struggle, Duty Taken Flags that we received from Anıtkabir and the Presidency of the Republic of Turkey, special flags that should be protected and hidden like Border Flags and transferred to future generations. In addition to these ,there are works of the period with the star theme of the row moon.

In the backyard of our museum, the Museum Cafe and Souvenir Shop serve as a social facility.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Every year, students studying at our university and in need of food by the Department of Health, Culture and Sports scholarship is given.

Dokuz Eylül University Scholarships Part-Time Work Opportunities

According to Article 46 of the Higher Education Law No. 2547, the Part-Time Student Employment Program requires the students studying at our university to work in a job in line with their interests and abilities.

To develop their skills and contribute to their upbringing as productive individuals with a business discipline according to the subject of associate, undergraduate and graduate education or personal interest, our students spend their free time in school periods it provides the opportunity to work to evaluate.

In this context; Following the start of the relevant academic year of our students who want to work part-time, following the job advertisements for part-time students to be recruited to work in the academic and administrative units of our university, they are required to apply online

through the official website of our university. An application other than online application is not accepted.

Students who are entitled to work part-time can work up to **15 hours** per week and up to **40 hours** not to pass this limit per month.

Requirements to be sought for students to be employed part time.

- To be a registered student of the higher education institution where he/she will be employed, except for the non-thesis master's student and private student,
- · Not having received disciplinary action,
- \cdot Not having an income at the minimum wage level other than orphan's pension and alimony,
- The contract has not been terminated due to the breach of the contract between the part-time student and the higher education institution
- · Having sufficient knowledge, skills and abilities for the work to be performed,
- · Not to be a student and a foreign student who freeze registration,
- · To study within the normal education period.
- (2) The above conditions are not sought for students who certify that they have been damaged by natural
 disasters such as earthquakes and floods, and that they have children of martyrs and veterans, and students
 with disabilities, except for being studying within the normal education period, not being a foreign student,
 and not receiving disciplinary punishment.

BEYOND DISABILITY DOKUZ EYLÜL

The main purpose of the Beyond Disability Dokuz Eylül Coordination Office, which was established in 2009, is to make all the opportunities offered by our university accessible and accessible in every sense for our students with special needs. The support and access services offered within the coordinatorship are not limited to our students and employees, but cover all our citizens in our region. Based on this idea, our university provides special needs students, employees and together with our citizens, we attach great importance to creating living spaces where the whole society can benefit equally and fairly.

The cafeteria named "Artı Bir" in the Buca Faculty of Education Campus, where the coordinatorship is also located. One of the most prestigious and up-to-date social projects that will serve a specific purpose he is seen as one.

In order to facilitate spatial accessibility, a barrier-free transportation service is offered to our students and citizens with special needs through our accessible bus services in Tinaztepe Campus. In order to provide visually impaired students at our university with access to information, Prof. Dr. Fuat Sezgin Central Library course resources and works are accessible through the hardware and software technologies they have for presenting in the formats.

Induction Loop System that enables hearing clear and healthy sounds in challenging acoustic environments in order to facilitate the access of hearing impaired students to social and cultural activities carried out indoors;

Our University Sabancı Cultural Center, Buca Faculty of Education Science Building, Prof. Dr. In Fuat Sezgin Central Library and Dokuz Eylül Distance Education Application and Research Center, Voice Guidance System to facilitate visually impaired students' access to indoor spaces;

Buca Faculty of Education Science Building, Prof. Dr. Fuat Sezgin Central Library was activated at the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences Multipurpose Activity Center and Dokuz Eylül Distance Education Application and Research Center.

Participation of students with special needs in decision-making processes is of great importance, for this purpose, "University Disabled Student Representation" and "Academic Unit Disabled Student Representation" mechanisms are operated, as well as "Disabled Student Advisors" who support our students in all aspects in academic units. Our coordinatorship has been deemed worthy of the "Unimpeded University Flag Awards" organized by the Council of Higher Education as a concrete proof of the activities carried out by our students with special needs in order to increase their educational opportunities, spatial

uses and accessibility to socio-cultural activities.

Our coordinatorship will increase its success every year compared to the previous year and continues to work with the aim of carrying out new activities and projects for individuals with special needs.

LIBRARIES

The information services of the university, which consists of many faculties and colleges in Izmir and surrounding provinces, are provided by Prof. Dr. Fuat Sezgin, together with the libraries in the Central Library and other faculties, total number of libraries is 12 these are: Buca Education F., Law F., Economics and Administrative Sciences F., Theology F., Medicine F., Torbalı Vocational School, Bergama Vocational School, Sea Sci. and Tech. Institution, the State Conservatory, Ephesus Vocational School and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine.

In this way, users' information requires high-quality service, under the leadership of a fast and professional team. Their total area is 19,410 m² and the total reader capacity is 2,448. Undergraduate and Associate students are entitled to receive 2 borrowed publications for 14 days.

The Central Library located in Tinaztepe Campus, during the academic calendar period, on weekdays and it is open 24/7 on weekends.

Libraries have a high-quality and rich collection of printed and electronic resources. Total printed books with unit libraries are 374,165; the number of electronic full-text books is 403,786; the total number of printed and e-books is 777,951. In order to benefit from the developments in electronic information access systems, our university has subscriptions to 73 electronic databases and 78,772 e-journals can be accessed within these subscriptions. Central and unit libraries host numerous scientific and cultural events in their meetings and halls.

In order to meet the information needs of our visually impaired users in our university, the "Visually Impaired Unit" serves within the Central Library. Our Visually Impaired Unit provides information services to our visually impaired users by using the hardware and software technologies it has. For visually impaired users, books are read aloud and recorded by volunteers in environments where technical rules are provided. With the announcement of 2020 as the 'Year of Accessibility' by our President, the 'Be the Voice of My Book' project, which will set awareness and an example in this regard, has been initiated. Thus, it was aimed to make our visually impaired students and visually impaired citizens benefit more from today's audio technologies and to improve our audiobook infrastructure. The project is ongoing and the number of volunteer readers who want to voice the book and our audiobook collection are increasing. This service is a first among university libraries in lzmir. Prof. Dr. Our Fuat Sezgin Central Library was awarded the "Accessibility in Space Award (Orange Flag)" within the scope of the Unobstructed University Flag awards organized by YÖK in 2021 and the "Accessibility Certificate and Accessibility Logo" in 2022 as a result of detailed audits by the Accessibility Monitoring and Supervision Commissions of the Ministry of Family, Labor and Social Services. **Phone:** 0 (232) 301 80 01

EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Erasmus+

Erasmus+ Exchange Program is a program that aims to exchange students, academicians and staff in the field of higher education of the European Union, to improve the quality of education, and to promote and disseminate the construction of projects in this direction. Within the scope of Erasmus+ Exchange Program; associate, undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students, education and internship mobility; teaching members can benefit from the mobility of teaching; administrative staff can benefit from the mobility of receiving training.

* As of 2023, Dokuz Eylül University has 293 inter-institutional agreements with 30 different countries.

* Since the academic year 2003–2004, a total of 3,499 students have studied abroad, 1,302 students came to our university from abroad to study.

Conditions for Students to Benefit from Erasmus+ Mobility

1. Being a citizen of the Republic of Turkey and/or a citizen of other countries, but being a full-time student registered at our university.

2. Students study abroad for a minimum of **2** months and a maximum of **12** months within the scope of this program they can see. A student can benefit from up to 12 months of study and internship mobility with or without grants in each of the **associate, bachelor, master** and **doctoral** programs throughout his/ her entire educational life. Students in the 4th year of their undergraduate degree can exercise these rights within one year following their graduation if they qualify to benefit from Erasmus+ internship mobility.

3. The student **must be enrolled in one of the associate, undergraduate, master and doctoral programs of the university that provide formal education during the period he/she will participate in the program.** Foreign language preparatory class, vertical transition preparatory program and adaptation program students, postgraduate scientific preparatory students and students studying in the first year of associate and undergraduate programs cannot benefit from the Erasmus+ program (preparatory class is not considered as 1st year).

4. First-year undergraduate, undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students can apply to the Erasmus+ program with a grade point average in the fall semester grade certificate.

5. The general grade point average of associate and undergraduate students who will apply to the program should be at least **2.20 in the 4-point system;** for graduate and doctoral program students, it should be at least **2.50.** Whether the minimum grade point average requirement is met in departments that are using the 100 system determined by the Council of Higher Education using the provisions specified in the prepared grade conversion schedule.

6. The student applies in accordance with the criteria determined by the National Agency through the university and the directions in the announcements shared on the **web page of the Foreign Relations**

Coordinator's Office (international.deu.edu.tr) between the announced dates (disciplinary action or having a lesson from the bottom does not prevent the student from applying).

7. The student chooses among the universities where he/she can go within the scope of bilateral agreements belonging to the department where he/she is registered.

8. All students applying for Erasmus+ study and internship mobility **are required to participate in the foreign language exam organized by Dokuz Eylül University School of Foreign Languages for the relevant Erasmus+ application period.** Documents to be brought by the students from foreign languages in which the exam is not held are also evaluated.

Rumi

Mevlana Exchange Program is a program that aims to exchange students and academic staff between the Turkish higher education institutions and higher education institutions abroad.

Students who want to participate in the exchange program can benefit from the program by going to higher education institutions that have agreements with Dokuz Eylül University in accordance with the country and field of education criteria determined by YÖK to study for at least 1 and maximum 2 semesters. Similarly, students of these overseas institutions can also study as exchange students at Dokuz Eylül University.

Application Requirements for Mevlana Exchange Program

1. If the student is an **associate degree**, **undergraduate**, **graduate** or **doctoral** student enrolled in higher education programs provided with formal education,,

2. The general academic grade **point** average of associate and undergraduate students should be at least 2.50 out of 4.00,

3.3 At least 3.00 out of 4.00 GPA is necessary for masters and doctoral students.

Students studying in the preparatory and first year of associate and undergraduate programs and graduate and doctoral students in the preparatory and scientific preparatory periods cannot benefit from this program for the first semester they start their primary education.

The Mevlana Exchange Program in our university was first implemented with the mobility carried out in the 2014–2015 academic year. In the meantime, agreements have been signed with universities from different countries, and there are also ongoing efforts to sign new agreements.

In line with the decision taken by YÖK due to the global COVID-19 pandemic, the Mevlana Exchange Program was suspended.

Al-Farabi

The Student and Faculty Exchange Program between Farabi Higher Education Institutions includes student exchange between higher education institutions that provide education at associate and undergraduate level within universities and high-tech institutes.

Farabi's education and training process aims to increase knowledge, skills and competencies in different centers. $^{\prime\prime}$

The Farabi Exchange Program allows students to continue their education in a different university and city for 1 or 2 semesters. Students who benefit from this program receive four months of free scholarships for the fall semester.

The minimum requirements for students applying to become a Farabi Exchange Program student are as follows:

1. If the student is an undergraduate student enrolled in higher education programs provided with formal education,

2. The general academic grade point average of the undergraduate students should be at least

2.00/4 .00. (In the equivalents of the grades in the 100 system in the 4 system, the decisions of the Council of Higher Education on this subject are taken as basis.)

Within the scope of the Farabi Exchange Program, exchange protocols covering all departments were signed with 86 universities.

In line with the decision taken by YÖK due to the global covid-19 pandemic, the Farabi Exchange Program was suspended.

DEPARK AŞ / DETTO / BAMBOO

Dokuz Eylül University Technopark - DEPARK Inc. Dokuz Eylül University Technology Development Zone (DEPARK), one of the technology development zones of strategic importance for the innovation ecosystem of Izmir and the Aegean Region, was established in 2013 as Turkey's First Health Specialization Technopark with the vision of developing new projects and collaborations in the field of health; today it is located in two different settlements in Dokuz Eylül University.

With its Alpha and Beta buildings in the Olive Building and Pomegranate Complex and Tinaztepe Campus in the 15 Temmuz Sağlık Ve Sanat Campus, DEPARK has a total closed area of 15.942 m² and has more than 125 R&D companies from different sectors as of 2023 and more than 1500 R&D personnel.

Contributing to the development of local and national development-oriented entrepreneurship with R&D and innovation-based projects and collaborations, DEPARK is located in a strong communication network through activities covering the national and international entrepreneurship ecosystem. It manages the preincubation and incubation processes of entrepreneurial and entrepreneurial candidates, and provides a suitable environment for companies in the development of sectoral R&D projects, on the way to incorporation and internationalization.

Students of all universities in Izmir and Aegean Region, especially Dokuz Eylül University, have internship and job opportunities in companies operating in DEPARK. In addition, by developing its R&D and innovation projects in the Bamboo Acceleration and Incubation Center, it can establish its companies in DEPARK by using the advantages of the technology development region. Our students can participate in project marathons (Hackathon), national and international events and competitions (Google Hash Code, etc.) organized or shared by DEPARK and meet with sector representatives for financing support for their projects. DEPARK defines students as the entrepreneurs of the future and contributes by supporting them with the entrepreneurship activities they need such as education, mentoring and consultancy.

Dokuz Eylül University Technology Transfer Office – DETTO

DETTO, which started its activities with the vision of transforming the information produced in the academic units within Dokuz Eylül University into economic value in the industry through technology transfer, has been entitled to receive financial support within the scope of TÜBİTAK 1513 Technology Transfer Offices Support Program since 2014. Today, DETTO continues to serve researchers, students and industry throughout the entire process from "idea to market".

By developing University-Industry R&D cooperation on a regional, national and international scale, especially in Izmir, DETTO aims to increase innovation and competitiveness in our industry, it helps to produce value added products. DETTO provides resources and infrastructure support to Dokuz Eylül University in the fields of R&D, innovation, entrepreneurship and commercialization in order to produce information and innovation and transform it into commercializable technological products and services for the benefit of the society, to create an effective University-Industry cooperation mechanism and to ensure its sustainability. It contributes to all stakeholders of Dokuz Eylül University in terms of increasing the number and quality of national and international R&D projects, developing university-industry collaborations, managing intellectual and industrial rights, and expanding entrepreneurship and corporate activities with the units within DETTO.

Bamboo Acceleration and Incubation Center

Bamboo Acceleration and Incubation Center, which started to operate under DEPARK in 2017, provides training, consultancy and mentoring services to entrepreneurs on issues such as creating and developing business models, benefiting from grant programs, intellectual property rights and companization in order to develop their ideas and projects.

Today, Dokuz Eylül University Tinaztepe Campus, Bamboo Acceleration and Incubation Center operating in DEPARK Alpha Building, supports the incorporation of business ideas by organizing acceleration programs in line with the mission of DETTO, and supports initiatives in many different fields such as nanotechnology, internet of things, advanced material technologies, wearable technologies, smart cities, health and good life technologies, information software technologies, digital game and animation technologies.

With opportunities such as prototyping workshop, shared office environment, meeting rooms and internet access for entrepreneurs, Bamboo Acceleration and Incubation Center has played an accelerating role in the development and strengthening of Dokuz Eylül University, DEPARK and DETTO entrepreneurship ecosystem.

With the support of external stakeholders and the knowledge of the faculties at the university, BAMBOO guides entrepreneur candidates with special acceleration programs in health, digital transformation, clean technologies and digital game vertical. The Digital Game Acceleration Program, which has been organized since 2020, has reached more than 400 entrepreneurs with the BAMBOO D² Game Study (BAMBOO D.O.S), provided more than 60 hours of field training, and as a result, it has become the largest digital game network in the Aegean Region with more than 10 incubators and more than 20 pre-incubators.

In addition, DEPARK has been entitled to be an implementing and executive organization for two years in the "1512 Techno-Entrepreneurship Capital Support Program (BİGG)" opened in 2020 within the scope of the "Support Program for Capacity Building in TÜBİTAK 1601 Innovation and Entrepreneurship Areas". A total of 41 projects were supported by TÜBİTAK in the BIGG Synergy program carried out by DEPARK between 2020-2022. Initiatives that tried to be supported were entitled to receive grants over 9.000.000 TL.

SYSTEM AND GRADE EVALUATION

At Dokuz Eylül University, education is carried out in academic units with passing or passing systems;

Grade Evaluation

A student who fails the number of courses specified in the education program of any class is unable to take anymore Lessons from the next academic year.

Completion of a Lesson

Courses that have not been completed in the curriculum of one academic year are registered with a priority in the next academic year.

At Dokuz Eylül University, a relative or absolute evaluation system is applied. Differences in students' passing status according to

academic units can show.

Relative evaluation

In order for the student to enroll in courses that he/she has not taken before, they must have achieved a GPA of at least 1.80 out of 4.00 as of the end of the second and subsequent semesters.

Absolute Evaluation

In order for the student to be considered successful in a course, he/she must have received the minimum passing grade specified in the application principles of the units from the end of the semester or make-up exam of that course.

Development and dissemination of quality culture in the university, establishment of internal and external quality assurance system of the university, monitoring the performance of the university and academic units, expectations, satisfaction and monitoring and evaluating feedbacks, conducting training on quality, organization.

Our Integrated Quality Policy

As Dokuz Eylül University Rectorate, the main activity of our university is Education-teaching, Research, Internationalization, Community Service, Management Integrated Quality Assurance System covering all aspects of the environment and energy The purpose of our Management System; meeting the needs and expectations of our stakeholders, to fulfill our responsibilities towards our employees, to continuously improve our service quality.

The purpose of our Integrated Management System, which includes all of the Quality Assurance System and Environment and Energy issues in system dimensions, is to meet the needs and expectations of our stakeholders, to fulfill our responsibilities to the society, the environment and our employees, and to continuously improve our service quality.

Dokuz Eylül University started its activities to increase quality assurance in education with the European Higher Education Adaptation Process, also known as the Bologna Process, which it started in 2010. Internal and external stakeholder analyses were carried out in all programs of our university, and educational objectives, course learning outcomes and program outcomes (program competencies) were determined. According to the European Credit Transfer System, ECTS credits of the courses are determined based on the student workload and published in Turkish and English in the course information package. The information package ensures that the qualifications provided to the graduates of the programs carried out in our University are presented in a transparent and comparable manner. As a result of the compliance with the European Credit Transfer System in terms of the execution of student mobility and the functionality of the information package within the scope of exchange programs, our university received the ECTS Label and the Diploma Supplement (DE) Label. The Diploma Supplement is a form designed to provide information in a comprehensible format on diplomas and degrees in the field of higher education in Europe and is a complementary document issued in addition to students' diplomas

in order to reinforce international transparency.

Since 2016, it has adopted a holistic approach by expanding the quality assurance system, education, research, management system, internationalization and social cohesion. For this purpose, the programs determine their strengths and developmental aspects in making their own evaluations with the participation of internal and external stakeholders. As a requirement of continuous improvement, all processes are carried out according to the principle of planning, implementation, control and prevention (PDCA). As a result of these studies, the programs received an accreditation certificate and were accredited by the Higher Education Council of our University.

In order to ensure the participation of our students, who are indispensable stakeholders of the quality assurance system, in these processes, the Quality Society was established in 2022 and it plays an important role in the development and dissemination of the quality culture of students in our University. The community organizes quality trainings, receives information about quality systems by making private sector visits, and ensures the spread of quality studies carried out in our university with social media tools. Community members work in the Quality Coordinator's office and contribute to the development of the quality assurance system carried out at our University.


